## Going “All In”

This year’s theme for the annual Denver Christmas Conference (December 28-January 2) was “All In.” Students practiced going “all in” by sharing their faith on New Year’s Eve at the 16th Street Mall, kicked off by a flash mob of over 1,000 students who stopped to “Tebow” (a praying pose named after quarterback Tim Tebow, who often kneels to pray on one knee with his fist on his forehead). Eight city blocks were covered with students praying for three minutes straight. It opened up an opportunity for students to have thousands of spiritual conversations.

### *Carissa's Story...*

“We were able to talk to Ruth, a lady from Germany. After asking how she would describe her life, she responded with one word, ‘lonely’. She had spent some time praying to God, but was feeling lost after her husband passed away three years ago. I [Carissa] was able to share the Gospel with her and a little bit of my personal story. After learning that she could have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ right there, Ruth was ready to accept him as her Savior. I left her with my Bible and phone number, in hopes of helping her grow in her new relationship with Jesus. I’m just so thankful for being trained in how to share my faith and speechless with how God would use me in Ruth’s life.”

Many of the students at DCC also went “all in” with their finances by giving over \$10,000 to help fund the 100,000 meals that they packed by hand at the conference. The meals will be sent to Haiti to help relieve some of the suffering there and show Christ’s love in a tangible way to people who desperately need it.
