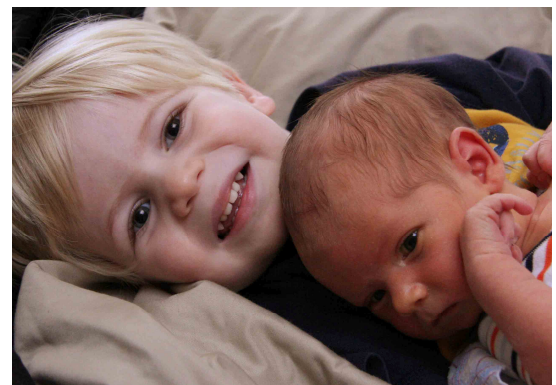
Both John and Kevin are finding hope, direction, and peace in their new relationships with God. We are grateful for the part you play in our ministry. Your giving and prayers change lives!
