During the first week of school JP came to an ultimate frisbee game that Cru was hosting on campus. After the game he and I exchanged information so that I could invite him to our next game. We ended up playing frisbee again that next week and then he invited me to play disc golf with him. While we played, he shared his life story with me and some of his life struggles. We were able to talk about God and some of his reasons for believing in God, but not believing that God is our Creator. I shared what I've learned through the Bible, but he didn't believe the Bible to be true. Afterward I thought he might not want to play again because of our differences in beliefs, but since then we've played disc golf 3 times and have had more great spiritual conversations.

I also got to meet Shawn, the second student I mentioned earlier, because he asked for information about Cru on the spiritual interest survey that he had filled out. Before long, we started talking about the gospel and when I told him that there wasn't any way we could earn our way into heaven, his response was, "Wait a minute, what do you mean?" I then read to him Ephesians 2:8,9 and explained that we are saved by grace through faith. I could tell that this was sounding familiar to him, but it wasn't clear in his mind. We talked for several minutes about this and the rest of the gospel and how important it is for a Christian to be in a community with other Christians. Afterward he told me that he would think about getting involved in a Bible study, but wasn't sure if he would.
